WHO ARE YOU A PRISONER TO?

An excerpt of a prophetic teaching from Apostle Anthony Nelson

Eph. 4:1: I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called.

- We were all born as prisoners to sin. This whole planet is a prison. You were born in a prison – a place where you're confined to your senses. The prince of the air is the prison warden and the keys he has is Death.
- We can't escape this prison. This is our sentence. If you don't think you're a prisoner, try to leave the planet all by yourself without any vehicles.
- Jesus Christ has come to deliver us from this present prison of sin. **The Apostle Paul recognized the only way to be free from one prison is to be a prisoner to Someone Else because your prison warden controls your destiny.** If I choose to submit to one Master, the other one has to fight Him to get to me.
- We are prisoners to our will. Whatever you will to do is what you're going to do. When a want becomes a need, you're no longer in control. That thing controls you. **Whatever controls your will controls you.**
- I thought there was no hope for me because I was a prisoner of a will that wasn't mine. I couldn't help myself. No matter how I tried to be good, there was another part of me that came over me. There was something in me that was pulling me back like a chain. When it calls you, you have to respond to it.
- If there's something in you that the enemy has, then you're a prisoner to that thing that controls you. You're disobeying God because the enemy has captivated you, and that leads to destruction.



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- You were born in a prison and the only answer is Christ. Come out and receive liberty! You can be taken out of a physical situation. **But the desire for your prison will still be there because it's in you until you decide that you're going to grow in your inner man.**
- When you can look at a desire and say, "No, I don't even want to think about that," your inner man is becoming strong enough to overcome. *Taken from the War Room of the Apostolic Training Center, Apr. 10, 2008.*
