GOING BEYOND YOUR QUITTING POINT

And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart (Gal. 6:9)



- **Quitting zone:** the point where you say no more.
- **Look at our own quitting places.** If not, you're going to make some mental, emotional and social decisions that will stop you from moving on in the promises of God for your life.
- **When you are betrayed, an internal decision is made.** You may not scream and shout. You may even keep on until you quit putting confidence in that person or on life. Then the believer in Christ will make some decisions on the inside that will affect his outside confession and his walk because of daily life and relationships breaking down.
- **Conflict comes when you have made a decision internally, but you're acting a different way on the outside.** But there will come a point when the internal decision you've made overrides the outward act and that is where you break.
- **Men and women need each other to balance their quitting areas.** A man will deal with betrayal by cutting it off; a woman will deal with it. Men will lock it away. A man has the ability to even have a no-fly zone in his mind. Women usually can't do that.
- **When a marriage covenant has God in the center, both the man and the woman come to God first and He sustains them in the marriage. When the other person in**

the marriage breaks down and quits, the One who never quits is in you and between you in the marriage. With Him you're able to run when the other one is quitting and failing and between the two of you, by God's grace, you'll be able to speak strength to each other. Be open to this before it reaches the stage where one person quits physically.

- **God designed us for lasting relationships.** But some of us weren't trained in an environment where quitting wasn't an option.
- **The measure a man is what it takes for him to bail out of a commitment with people.** And once it's been done, it'll be done again.
- **We often work with an individual that has a different quitting point than us. But if I come to my end and the other person is prepared to go on, my commitment to that person will cause me to go past my point.** We will go as far as the commitment of the stronger one.
- When you're only committed to yourself and you reach your quitting zone, there won't be anyone to stop you. **Therefore, make sure you're committed to someone stronger than yourself. That's why being in fellowship with the Body of Christ is so important.**
- **Move past your quitting threshold by committing to a vision, idea, or person that you know is stronger than you.** First your body will be struggling to get into the commitment, but with discipline it will line up, then because of maturity in Christ, you will be able to help someone go beyond their quitting point. – Taken from the Apostolic Training Center, Sun.
